

Basic Cruising and Bareboat Chartering course: March 29–April 4,

2017 Earn Basic Cruising (ASA 103) and Bareboat Chartering (ASA 104) while enjoying a beautiful vacation in the British Virgin Islands. Our live-aboard yacht is a 45' sloop from The Moorings <http://www.moorings.com/charter-fleet/moorings-454-4-cabin-monohull> with 4 cabins and 2 heads. Start at The Moorings base in Road Town, Tortola with a sleep-aboard the evening of March 29. We set sail each morning, and anchor off a different island each afternoon. During the day, we will learn navigation, boat systems, diesel engine checks, crew overboard techniques, emergency procedures, reefing, anchoring, sail trim, cooking underway, live-aboard skills and a half day of docking practice. Upon successful completion of on-water skills and written exams, you will be certified to skipper your own charter yacht. Snorkeling, swimming, hiking time included. All are welcome on this cruise, though ASA 101 is the prerequisite for certifications. **ITINERARY: Board March 29 at 6PM – Sleep aboard, then set sail after orientation in the morning. Live aboard while learning each day. We will explore many different islands after sailing each day. Return April 4 and disembark at 12PM.**

Cruising Catamaran and Bareboat Chartering course: April 12–18,

2017 – Earn Cruising Catamaran (ASA 114) and Bareboat Charter (ASA 104) certifications while enjoying the luxury of a roomy catamaran from The Moorings. Start at The Moorings base in Road Town, Tortola with a sleep-aboard the evening of April 12. Learn how to maneuver a twin-engine catamaran under power and under sail, completing both ASA 114 and ASA 104 skills (above). Snorkeling, swimming, hiking time included. Prerequisite is Basic Cruising (ASA 103), but those not seeking certification are invited to join this course and participate as much as desired. **ITINERARY: Board April 12 at 6PM – Sleep aboard, then set sail after orientation in the morning. Live aboard while learning each day. We will explore many different islands and anchor off a different island each night. Return April 18, disembarking by 12PM.**

Shared double berth, bed linens, towels. Optional shore school in Minneapolis 9AM–5PM on February 4. Packing list and textbooks will be sent upon registration. (ASA 101 is prerequisite for this course.)

Catamaran Fun Week: April 5–11: \$2567 per double cabin (for one or two people). Food additional. No prerequisites.

Cruising Catamaran course: April 12–18: \$1759. Included: Textbooks, Cruising Multihull & Bareboat Cruising Made Easy, ASA certifications, 6 breakfasts, 5 lunches, tropical drink nightly, snorkel, mask, fins. Shared double berth, bed linens, towels. Optional shore school in Minneapolis 9AM–5PM on February 4. Packing list and textbooks will be sent upon registration. (ASA 103 is prerequisite for this course.)
